## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

The Monroe County Fair has established a tradition of providing a Fair that is enjoyable, clean, and wholesome with a commitment to total guest satisfaction. As an exhibitor you are required to help maintain these high standards.

- Keep aisles free of debris, equipment, or obstacles at all times.
- Please pay attention to the entrance and exits of buildings to keep free of any obstacles, obstructions, or debris. Please clean up after your animal if you are leading it around.
- Please be available to provide information about your exhibit or give directions if needed.
- Be aware that the fair ends on Sunday and you are required to maintain your animal throughout the entire fair. Make sure your animals have food and water the entire time.
- If you encounter a fairgoer that you feel their behavior or picture taking is inappropriate, please contact a board member or the main office.
- If someone has questions you cannot answer, please direct them to the Fair office.

## **CAMPING ON FAIRGROUNDS or in our Campground off of CM**

Anyone camping on the grounds or in our CM lot must register for an assigned camping site. Regardless of whether you are using a tent, camper, or cattle trailer to sleep in: **YOU MUST REGISTER!** If you are not registered with the fair office, you will be fined and could be asked to remove your unit from the camping area(s). \*Registration Form will be found online or call the office to have one emailed or picked up at the Fair Office. The fee for camping this year will be \$75.00 per site per exhibitor or \$100.00 non-exhibitor.

## **SAWDUST/SHAVINGS FOR BEDDING**

The Monroe County Fair will only provide bedding for the showrings. You will need to provide your own bedding for your stalling. **Please note:** On Sunday after removing livestock, please clear **ALL** used bedding to the aisle from the stalls, except for outside stalls.

## **ENTRY TAG PICKUP**

The Monroe County Fair holds a fair cleanup day the Saturday prior to fair week. The Fair secretary will be handing out exhibitor entry tags for your convenience from 9:00am – 11:00am. (**DO NOT** lose these tags, they **WILL NOT** be reprinted, this is for your convenience to help get your entries marked beforehand.) Fair clean update is July 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026 starting at 9:00am. Happy fair planning!
